- The kite requires a minimum wind of $7 \mathrm{mph} / 11.3 \mathrm{kph}$. Let out approximately 75 feet / 22.9 m of line and have an assistant hold the kite.
- With your back to the wind, release the kite and take a few steps backwards, the kite will rise into the air. Tug line to gain altitude, let out line to gain distance.
- For storage, reverse assembly steps and place into package. Store your kite in a cool dry place. Excessive heat and/or sunlight can damage the package and
kite.
